Dr. Clayton Petro is a partner in abdominal wall reconstruction at the Cleveland Clinic. He is a co-chair of the ACHQC Opioid Task Force and now serves as surgical director of the Simulation and Advanced Skills Center. As a member of the highly productive Cleveland Clinic Center for Abdominal Core Health research team, Dr. Petro was recognized with this year's SAGES Early Career Faculty Researcher Award for his work in running randomized clinical trials and opioid research relative to the ACHQC.

Dr. Michael (Micki) Reinhorn co-founded Boston Hernia, a specialized ambulatory hernia practice. His practice focuses on inguinal hernias to provide an optimal level of specialized and personalized care for patients suffering from this condition. He founded and is now co-chair of the Opioid Reduction Task Force of the ACHQC. He is an associate clinical professor of surgery at Tufts University. Dr. Reinhorn is a consultant for the American Board of Surgery in hernia surgery.
