

Entering Additional Long-Term Follow Up in OBERD

Two Steps

1. Determine if the patient has had a reoperation (usually for recurrence, but can be for other issues such as SSI, fistula, etc.)
 - Obtain this from the EMR, similar to how you would determine if any patient had a reoperation since their hernia operation
 - ALL patients should have an assessment for reoperation entered (yes or no)
2. Determine if the patient has had a recurrence and SSI/SSO
 - Obtain this from the EMR by checking if there is a documented abdominal exam (from any provider) or any radiographic study (CT, MR, US) covering the area of the hernia repair
 - Recurrence and SSI/SSO assessment (yes or no) should be entered only if there is a documented abdominal exam or radiographic study covering the area of the hernia repair

1. For the reoperation assessment, the time window should be the most recent one and date of assessment is the date you do the lookup
2. For recurrence and SSI/SSO assessment, the time window should be the one that includes the date of the abdominal exam and/or radiographic study
 - If multiple assessments on different dates fall within a single OBERD time window, just enter everything within that window
 - If multiple assessments on different dates fall into separate time windows, enter into each separate time window
 - Generally speaking, you can just enter the most recent abdominal exam or radiographic study
